## STON AND NERETVA VALLEY DAY TOUR SATURDAY 19/10/2019



Just 1 hour driving distance from Dubrovnik lays unspoiled, beautiful area of Ston and Neretva Valley known by its flourishing fauna and flora as well as ancient and unique historical and cultural sites.

### What You Can Expect

This tour takes you to the Ston, a small medieval town whose history goes back as far as the fourteenth century with the second longest walls in Europe (5.5 km), known as the „European wall of China“, and the oldest active salt works in the world. Your second stop would be an unforgettable Mandarin harvest picking or at least you can walk through the numerous Mandarin plantations. After an unforgettable fruit experience you will board a traditional Neretva boats called 'trupice' that have been in use for ages for fishing and transportation. Sailing through the Neretva Valley would uncover various hidden beauties of both local fauna and flora. Your next stop would be Archaeological museum Naron in the village of Vid. There, you could see the remains of a Roman temple – the Augusteum – and 17 marble statues, both outsized and in natural height. Your final destination is a very attractive location next to the river bank where you would have lunch and enjoy local cuisine.
